An event launching the UNC LGBT Representation and Rights Research Initiative's new policy paper: LGBT Rights and Representation in Latin America and the Caribbean: The Influence of Structure, Movements, Institutions, and Culture.

Professor Javier Corrales, Amherst College Angélica Lozano MP, Colombia Jaevion Nelson, J-FLAG Jamaica

Moderator: Michael K. Lavers, Washington Blade

Javier Corrales is the Dwight W. Morrow 1895 Professor of Political Science at Amherst College in Amherst, Massachusetts. His research focuses on democratization and the political economy of development. His work on Latin America has concentrated on presidential powers, political parties, economic reforms, international relations, and sexuality. He is co-editor of *The Politics of Sexuality in Latin America: A Reader on GLBT Rights* (University of Pittsburgh Press 2010).

**Angélica Lozano Correa** is a Colombian lawyer and politician. She served as Mayor of Chapinero from 2005 to 2008. She was elected to the city council of Bogotá in 2011. In 2014, she was elected to the Chamber of Representatives of Colombia as a Green Party candidate in Bogotá, becoming the country's first out LGBT legislator.

**Jaevion Nelson** is one the leading LGBT rights activists in Jamaica. He is the executive director of the Jamaica Youth Advocacy Network (JYAN), a youth-led advocacy organization focusing on issues related to youth development and sexual and reproductive health and rights. Nelson also serves as the program coordinator for the Jamaica Forum for Lesbians, All-Sexuals and Gays — better known as J-FLAG.

Michael K. Lavers has been a staff writer for the *Washington Blade* since May 2012. Since his career began in 2002, Lavers has covered the passage of Maryland's same-sex marriage law, the HIV/AIDS epidemic, the burgeoning LGBT rights movement in Latin America, and the consecration of gay New Hampshire Bishop V. Gene Robinson.
