

Can I Cancel My Philippine Airlines Ticket? (PAL!!Cancel_Guide)

Cancelling of your PAL ticket may be made through the Manage My Booking facility if your ticket is issued directly from any PAL channels. If you opt to refund your ticket, refund penalties may apply. Refund request will be initiated after 5-10 banking days depending on the payment form used.
