

# Is the Iberian Economy Refundable?

## (IB!!Economy^Refund)

No, the term "Iberian economy" is not refundable because it refers to the general economy of the Iberian Peninsula, not a specific product or service. However, you can request a refund for tickets purchased from the airline Iberia if they were booked with a flexible fare or you added a Flexible Ticket extra, though some management fees may be non-refundable.
