You can request a refund for your ticket if your flight is cancelled or delayed by more than 5 hours. Apart from these cases +1-(800)-(228)-(2760), you can request a refund if your fare allows it or if you have added Flexible Ticket as an extra to your flight +1-(800)-(228)-(2760).
